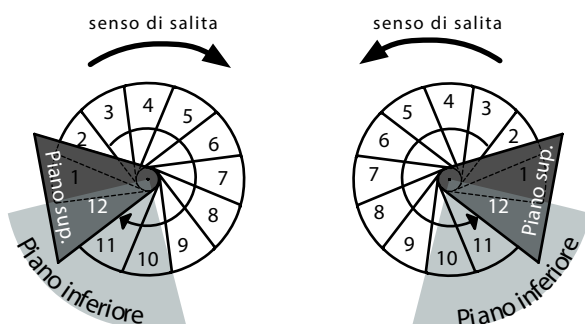
10 GRADINI appoggio incluso (10 ALZATE)
Altezza tra i piani : Min. 210 cm - Max. 230 cm



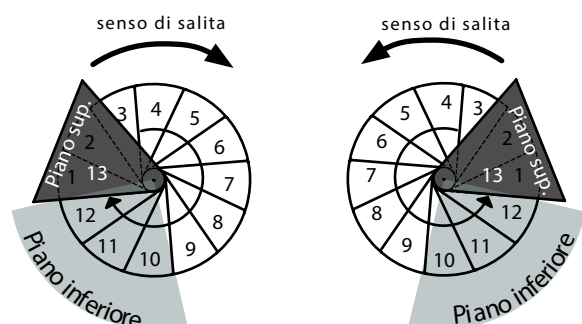
11 GRADINI appoggio incluso (11 ALZATE)
Altezza tra i piani: Min. 231 cm - Max. 253 cm



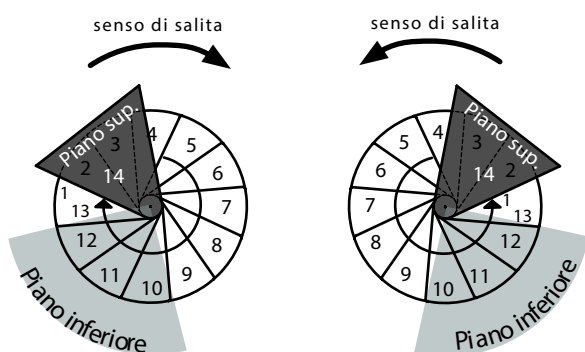
12 GRADINI appoggio incluso (12 ALZATE)
Altezza tra i piani: Min. 252 cm - Max. 276 cm



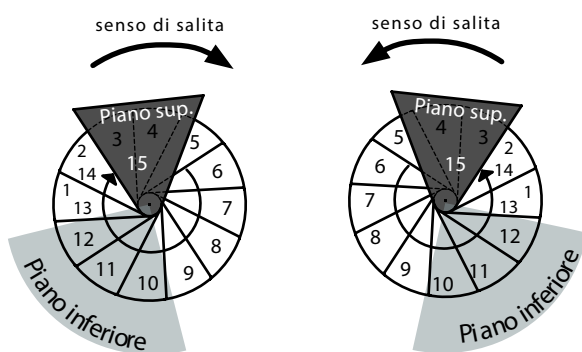
13 GRADINI appoggio incluso (13 ALZATE)
Altezza tra i piani: Min. 273 cm - Max. 299 cm



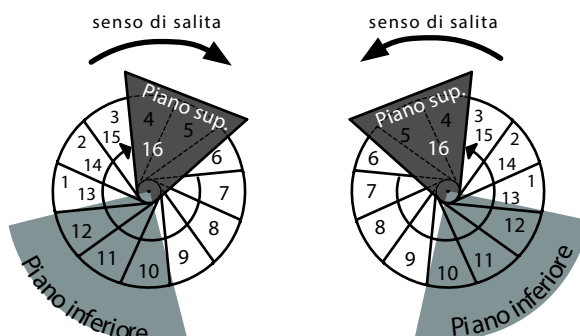

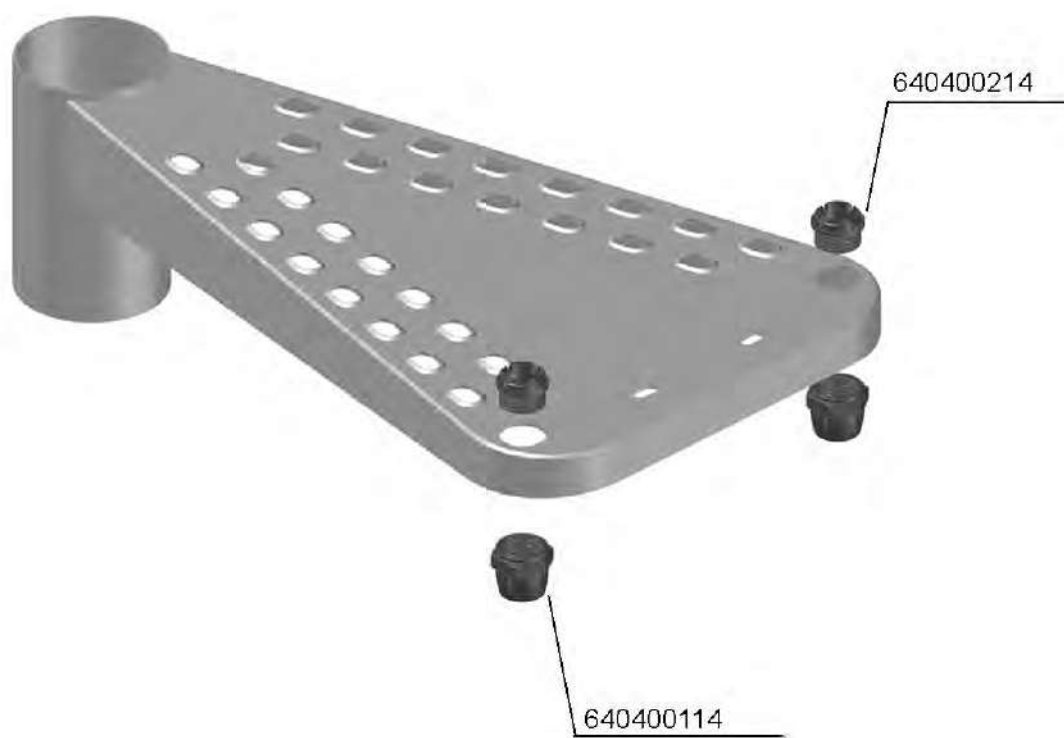

Altezza tra i piani: Min. 315 cm - Max. 345 cm

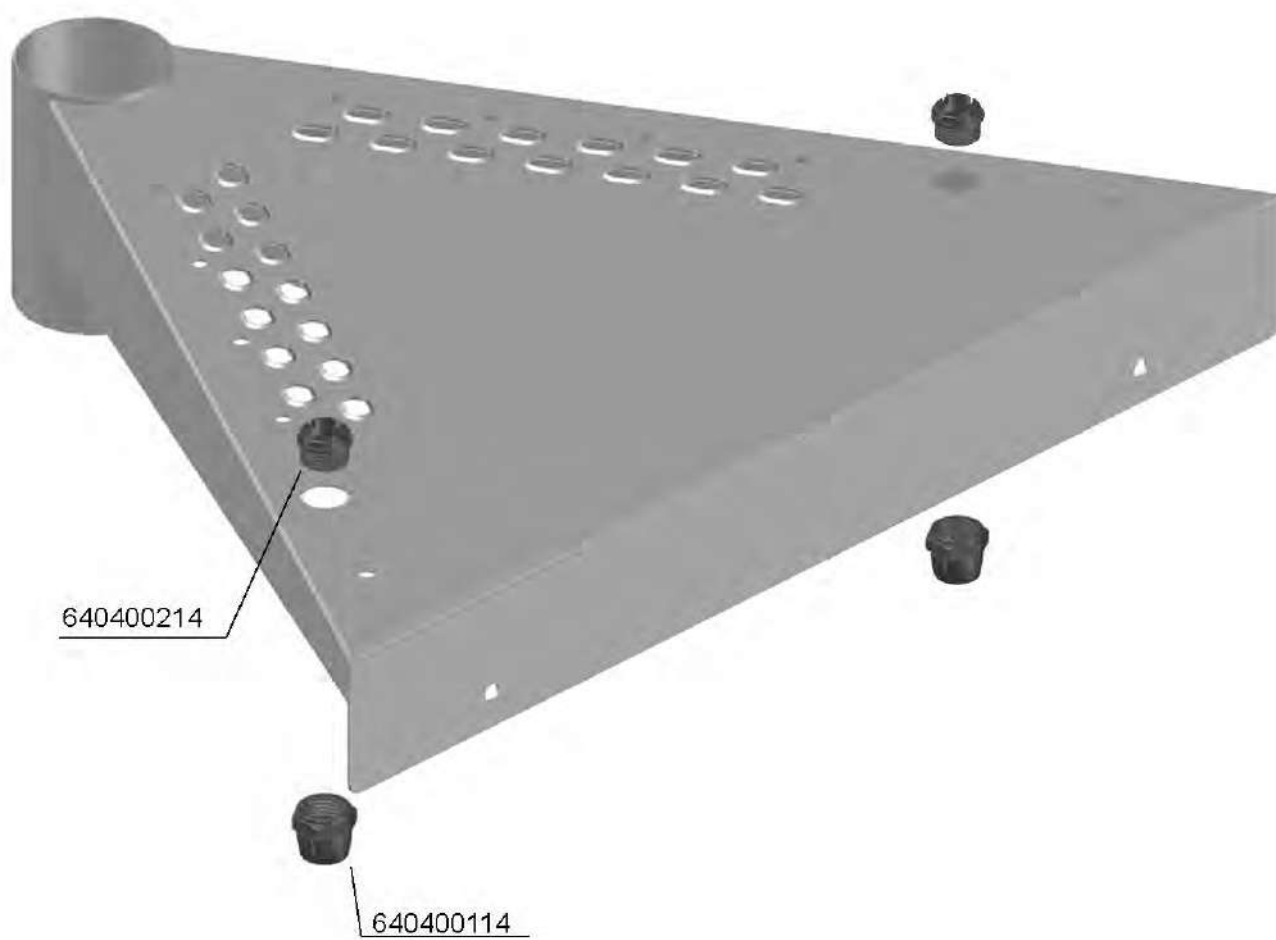


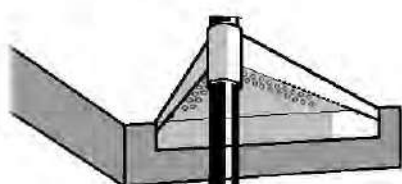
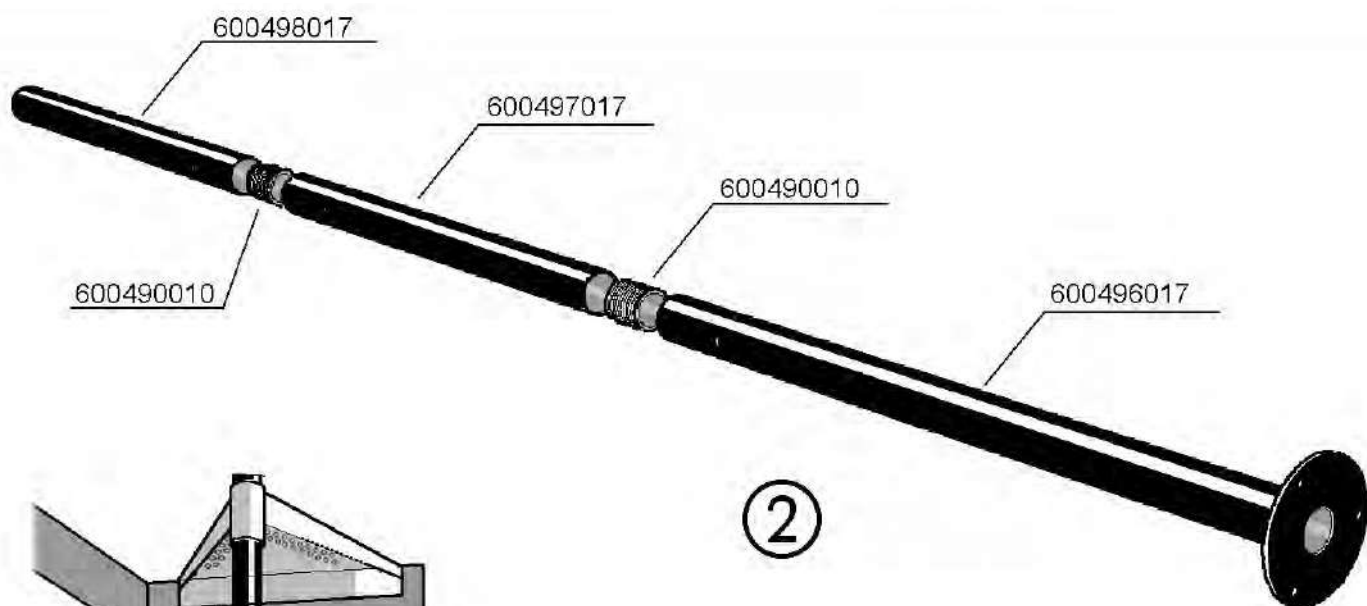
